

## **Declaration of Voluntary Resigned Member Status**

A Full Member may voluntarily become a Resigned Member at any time upon submitting a completed and signed copy of this form indicating the intention to permanently cease working in the Union's jurisdiction. The change in status will affect your insurance and retirement benefits therefore we highly recommend that you contact your insurance provider before you resign.

The UBCP/ACTRA Bylaws, ACTRA Constitution and Bylaws state that a Resigned Member:

- remains a Member while in Resigned status and therefore is subject to discipline and possible fines upon reinstatement or reactivation of their member status if contraventions, such as work on non-signatory productions occurred.
- must not work on non-signatory productions, including but not limited to struck or locked out work for an Unfair Engager,
- must reinstate as a Full Member to work on unionized productions. The Union has the right to refuse reinstatement and or impose fines for reasons provided in the ACTRA Constitution and Bylaws such as, but not limited to work on non-signatory productions.
- must pay non-member service charges on residual and royalty payments as per the ACTRA Constitution and Bylaws.
- Resigned Members lose benefits such as: access to education offerings at below market prices, free taping facilities, voting rights, participation in industry events, social functions, and committees.

<b>Note:</b> Given the above consequences, you may want to consider Withdrawn status instead.
